### News from Tearfund Heart for Lebanon

Resumption of fighting in southern Syria is putting the lives of hundreds of thousands of civilians risk. Attacks have hit more displaced families, killing and injuring children and women who were fleeing for their lives. More than 330,000 people have now been driven out – the largest ever displacement in the Syrian war. The families currently fleeing for their lives include local aid workers, who have themselves become targets, and evacuated people in need of help. Reports have been received of pregnant women giving birth out in the open and children dying because of the lack of medical assistance. The fighting is also getting near the Jordanian border, where thousands have nowhere left to go. Pray for peace and pray for Heart for Lebanon as we continue to see Syrian people in dire need of physical, emotional, and spiritual help. We can do more with your prayer and financial investment.
